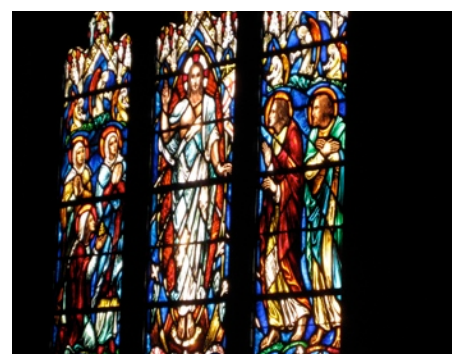
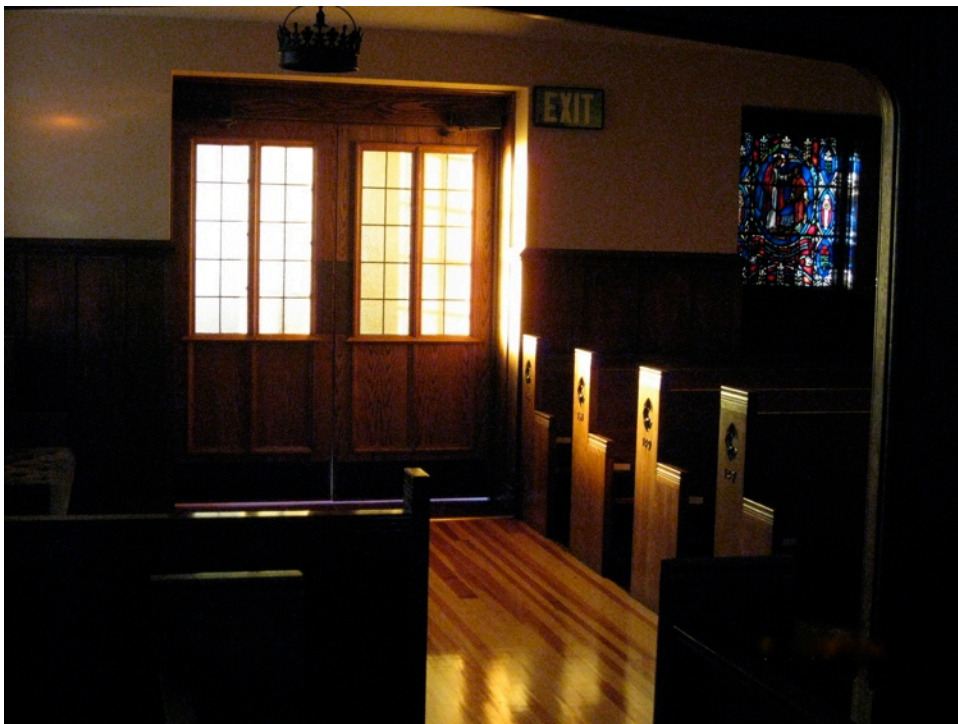


The Passion Vigil -2011

FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AND
24 HOURS TO FOLLOW IN JESUS' FOOTSTEPS



The **Passion Vigil** is a time of watching and waiting as we read, pray and experience the events of Jesus' last hours of life on earth before the crucifixion. It is a holy day...a day set apart and we have used this time every year to focus our minds and hearts on the life and death of Jesus so that we can be ready for Easter, the Resurrection and a week of Christian service in Honduras.

We have done lots of fund-raising and with it team-building has been happening. The Vigil is expressly for Soul-Preparation. It is as important if not **the** more important part of getting ready for mission work of any kind. You've got to know why we do what we do. Understanding the motivation for Christians to serve the world is key to being ready to "go on mission." The Vigil begins on April 21 (Maundy Thursday) with the Seder meal at 5:30pm. It is followed by the Maundy Thursday Worship Service at 7:30 pm and then an overnight "vigil" that runs through Friday, April 22 concluding at 5:30 pm. During the overnight, there are numerous and varied activities and spiritual disciplines to engage the participants' minds and hearts.

More Information:

- As part of your soul's preparation for the trip to Honduras, you are expected to participate in as much of the Vigil as possible. **Adult travelers** are asked to attend the Seder and the Maundy Thursday service at All Souls unless you have a similar event at your own place of worship. **Student travelers** are asked to attend the Seder and the Vigil.
- Bring your Bible, sleeping bag, comfortable clothing, a willing soul, permission slip, \$5.00, pencil or pen, toiletries.
